A Tale for the Time Being

by Ruth Ozeki

In Tokyo, sixteen-year old distraught Nao wants to end it all but plans to first document the life of her great grandmother, a Buddhist nun who's lived more than a century. A diary is Nao's only solace, a diary that will touch lives in ways she can scarcely imagine. Across the Pacific is Ruth, a novelist living on a remote island who discovers a collection of boxed artifacts washed ashore, possibly debris from the devastating 2011 tsunami. As the mystery of its contents unfolds, Ruth is pulled into the past, into Nao's drama and her unknown fate, and forward into her own future.
